Requirements

- Design a mural that reflects the theme of your category.
- Entries must be submitted on 17”x11” tabloid paper.
- Entries must be titled and submitted with a completed entry form.
- Entries submitted must be the original artwork of each student entering the competition.
- Entries should not have been entered into any prior competition.
- Once submitted, entries will become the property of the Forestry Department.
- Schools are allowed a maximum of five (5) entries.
- Entries will be evaluated on creativity, uniqueness, interpretation of the themes, visual impact and balance.
