

THE FOREST ACT

The Forest (Intention to Declare Forest Reserve) (Ramble, St. Ann) Notice, 2026

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 10 (1) (a) of the Forest Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made: –

1. This Notice may be cited as the Forest (Intention to Declare Forest Reserve) (Ramble, St. Ann) Notice, 2026.
2. It is the Minister's intention to declare by order under section 5, the area described and delineated in Parts I and II of the Schedule to this notice, to be a forest reserve.
3. Members of the public may, if they so desire, provide written comments to the Minister, in relation to the proposed order, within ninety days from the date of publication of this notice to:

Part 1

Description of Ramble, St. Ann Forest Reserve Area

The Ramble, St. Ann Forest Reserve Area is described as follows:

All that parcel of Crown Land situated in the parish of St. Ann, containing by survey 4.0196 hectares, registered at Volume 965 Folio 403 in the name of The Commissioner of Lands, butting and bounded as follows:

Northerly on lands registered at Volume 140 Folio 10;

Northeasterly on lands registered at Volume 624 Folio 35;

Easterly on lands registered at Volume 282 Folio 9;

Southerly on lands owned by Bertram Gayle and on lands owned by Leslie

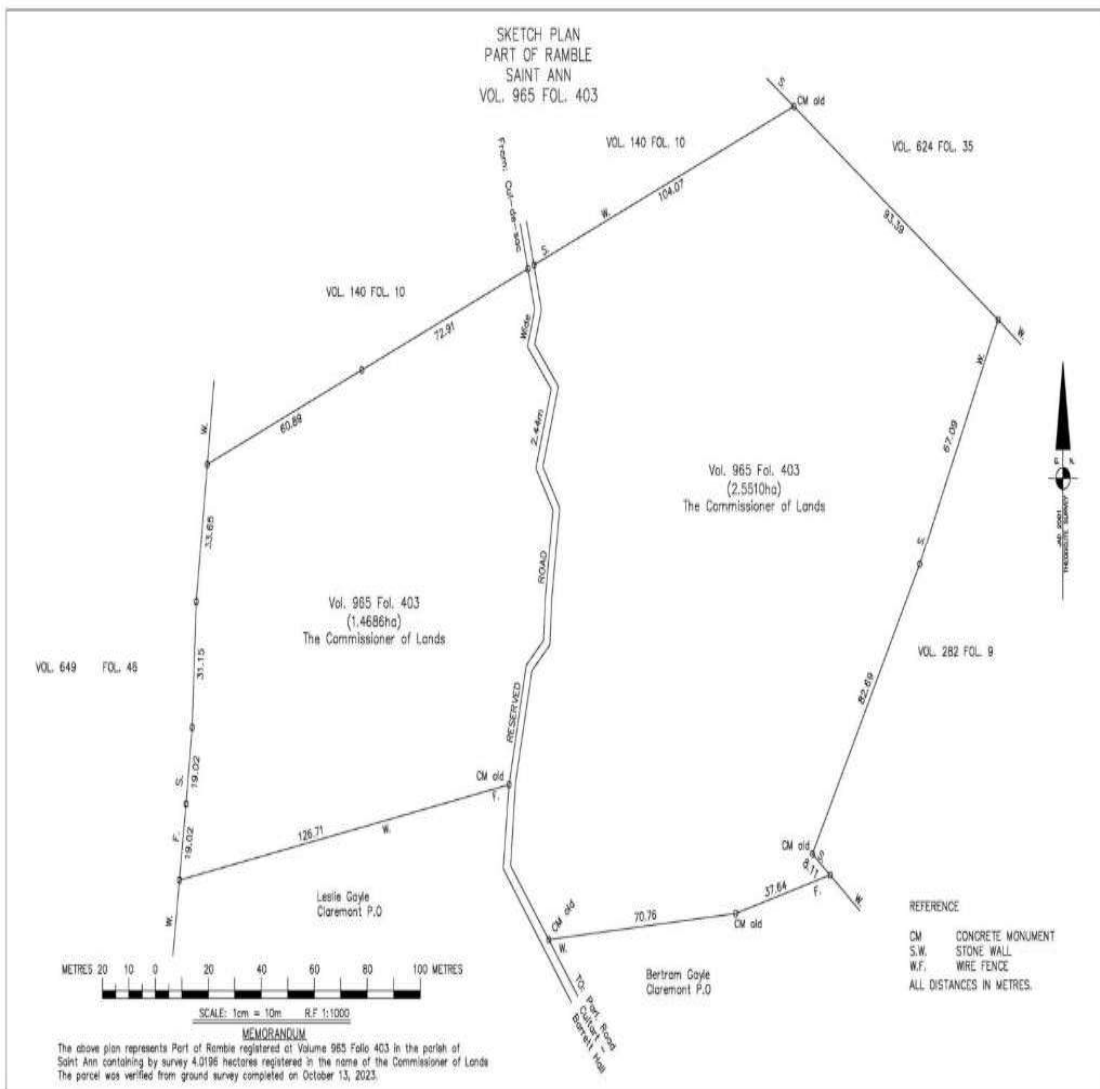
Gayle;
